HEALTH EDUCATION

To create awareness and knowledge about promotion of health and disease prevention, rather than treatment of diseases only.

QUALITY MEDICAL CARE

- To provide quality medical care in a clean and congenial atmosphere at minimal cost to the poor patients.
- To provide continuity of care to those suffering from chronic diseases.

SPECIALIZED MEDICINE

BUILDING PROJECT

- Phase-I: Restructuring of half of the ward and office space
- Phase-2: Demolition of Female wing & half of the service area & offices
- Phase-3: Reconstruction of Male & Female Ward , ICU, Office space for junior doctors and nurses
- Phase-4: Construction of 1st Floor
Seminar Hall/Examination Hall, Tutorial rooms, Postgraduate student's room, Library, Computer Lab , Skills Lab & Laboratory
- Phase-5: Demolition of the Male wing
- Phase-6: Construction of Out-patient area (Specialty clinics), remaining offices & lecture room
- Phase- 7: Construction of Second Floor
